

*Constitution  
Of The  
Wilson Area Railroad Modelers Inc.*

ARTICLE I

SECTION I

The name of this incorporated organization shall be the WILSON AREA RAILROAD MODELERS INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE II

SECTION I

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote the hobby of model railroading. Specifically to educate interested parties in the proper techniques of building, maintaining, and operating a model railroad layout.

ARTICLE III

SECTION I

Any person or persons interested in model railroading as a hobby regardless of age, sex, race, creed, or national origin is eligible for membership in this organization.

SECTION II

Application for membership in this club shall constitute a simple written statement of desire, signed by the applicant and submitted to the board of directors for approval.

SECTION III

For the purpose of this constitution, this organization will have two kinds of membership: active and honorary as set forth and described in the bylaws of this club.

ARTICLE IV

SECTION I

The officers of this club shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and a Treasurer.

SECTION II

A board of directors shall be comprised of seven members including the above named officers and three individuals as directors elected from membership, one each year to serve a three year term.

### SECTION III

Committees shall be formed whenever deemed advisable by the president.

### SECTION IV

A Committee Chairman shall be appointed by the president with the approval of the board of directors.

### SECTION V

The term of office for all officers and committee chairman shall be one year from the date of installation. Board members for three years or until their successors are elected and qualified.

## ARTICLE V

### SECTION I

Officers shall be elected by a majority of the general membership providing quorum is present and voting.

### SECTION II

Vacancies created in the board of directors by the loss of any officer or director for whatever reason shall be filled by the appointment of an interim replacement by the remaining board members until such time as an election can be held by the general membership to fill that position.

### SECTION III

Any officer or director can be removed from office by a two-thirds majority vote of the general membership providing a quorum is present and voting. Committee chairman can be removed by a two-thirds majority vote of the board of directors providing a quorum is present and voting.

## ARTICLE VI

### SECTION I

Amendments to this constitution shall be made through revision in the bylaws of this club, as set forth in article IX of the bylaws.

## ARTICLE VII

### SECTION I

Upon dissolution of this organization, all properties both real and personal belonging in their entirety to the club shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder. Any monies derived from the sale of said properties and any existing funds in the club treasury shall be used to satisfy any indebtedness against the club. Remaining funds, if any, shall be donated to a charitable cause as agreed upon by the board of directors. Any deficits to this indebtedness shall be covered by the assessment of the general membership for the balance due.
